Work teams came and readied our facility by caring for the grounds, refinishing the porch rockers, planting grass, burning debris, cleaning cabins and windows in various buildings. The new drywall in the MAC was painted in time for camp to start! A sewing team shared their talents by transforming 70 yards of fabric into new curtains for all the cabin bathrooms. Another sewing team made bags to be used for crafts. Another volunteer created and sewed a bear costume, volunteer cooks for staff training, drivers for supplies, and so many others gave time and resources for programing needs. Nurses volunteered their time to provide care around the clock for distributing medications and caring for scrapes, cuts, sprains, etc. as well as listening ears for campers "needing a mother's care". Many hours and many hands volunteered to clear the hillside and construct new steps to make a way from the upper camp to the MAC. When "The Storm" came through, taking trees down and destroying Cabin #1, neighbors, friends, board members and their wives showed up immediately to offer assistance in cleanup so camp programming could continue without interruption. Gifted speakers came and shared not only the Gospel of Jesus Christ but also their time, building relationships with campers and staff. Staff began training in June to become an incredibly unified group for an amazing summer of EXTREMES---most campers ever, hottest summer ever, drought conditions (only 1 campfire during 'Summer 2012' - on the first night of camp!), more broken/damaged equipment/buildings than any summer on record.
