Over the last 4 years we have given a major face lift to the cabins that our campers stay in. One cabin each year. Come the first of May we should be putting the final touches on Cabin # 2. That means NONE of our campers will be staying in an "OLD Cabin" this year. The cost of this project will end up at approx. \$70,000 with most of the labor by our Camp Manager Tim Tomcik and an assortment of volunteer help!. Two of the cabins have furnaces and two are handicap accessible. All of these cabins now meet state building codes and are equipped with hardwired fire alarm systems.
